§ 20-105. Open Burning. [Ord. 2008-5, 8/5/2008, § 105]

- No person shall ignite, cause, feed, permit or maintain any open fire for the destruction of solid waste or recyclables, to include leaf waste, designated in this Part on any property under his control, except as hereinafter provided.
 - A. Exceptions to Open Burning Prohibition.
 - (1) Open fires may be set in the performance of an official duty of any public officer if the fire is deemed necessary for the prevention of a fire hazard, which cannot be abated otherwise; and for the protection of public health.
 - (2) No open burning shall occur during any fire ban emergency declared pursuant to this provision.
 - (3) Nothing contained herein shall prohibit a farmer from carrying out the normal activities of his farming operations, provided such activities are conducted in accordance with all applicable laws, rules and regulations.
 - (4) Campfires and wood fires for food preparation.
