

RESOLUTION NO. 2014 - 38

RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND AMENDING ADDITIONAL RULES
AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE AND ENJOYMENT OF
PINEBROOK, BRODHEAD CREEK, YETTER AND CREEKVIEW PARKS

The Board of Supervisors of Stroud Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, hereby adopts the following Resolutions at a special meeting held on May 19, 2014 at 2:00 P.M., at the Stroud Township Municipal Center, to wit:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Stroud Township, pursuant to Section 2201, entitled "Acquisition of Lands and Buildings", of Article XXII, entitled "Parks, Recreation Centers and Forests", of the Second Class Township Code, Act of November 9, 1995, P.L. 350, No. 60, found at 53 P.S. 67201, has acquired interests in certain lands, known as Pinebrook, Brodhead Creek, Yetter and Creekview Parks, situate adjacent to and near by the Brodhead Creek, in the Township of Stroud, County of Monroe, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for park and recreational purposes for enjoyment by local citizens and taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has expended, and continues to expend, considerable Township tax revenues and funds for the acquisition, improvement, maintenance, upkeep, grounds-care, and clean-up, among other expenses, for the said Pinebrook, Brodhead Creek, Yetter and Creekview Parks; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to limit the free use and enjoyment of the said park lands to local residents and taxpayers, who bear the financial burden and expense for the said parks;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved as follows, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Stroud Township hereby adopts the following additional Rules and Regulations governing the use and enjoyment of Pinebrook, Brodhead Creek, and Yetter Parks and the area outside of premises leased to Stroudsburg

Little League, Inc. at Creekview Park, to wit:

(a) The free use and enjoyment of Pinebrook and Brodhead Creek Parks is hereby limited and restricted to the residents and taxpayers of Stroud Township, and of such other municipalities within Monroe County, Pennsylvania, that may enter into reciprocal recreational use agreements with the Board of Supervisors of Stroud Township.

(b) Those persons seeking to freely use and enjoy Pinebrook and Brodhead Creek, Parks shall exhibit, upon request, to an authorized agent or representative of Stroud Township, an appropriate proof of residency within Stroud Township, or such other municipality within Monroe County, Pennsylvania, that may have entered into reciprocal recreational use agreements with the Board of Supervisors of Stroud Township.

(c) Any other person who enters Pinebrook and Brodhead Creek Parks, who is not authorized hereunder to the free use of the said park lands, is hereby required and mandated to pay a "daily use fee" in such amount and in such manner as may be designated by resolution approved by the Board of Supervisors, and as may be amended, from time to time.

(d) All officers of the Stroud Area Regional Police Department, all Pennsylvania State Constables, and all other law enforcement officers are hereby authorized and directed to remove any person(s), who enter Pinebrook and Brodhead Creek Parks, who do not qualify for entry to the said park lands as herein provided.

(e) Beginning May 24, 2014 through September 1, 2014, picnicking at Pinebrook, Brodhead Creek, and Yetter Parks and the area outside of premises leased to Stroudsburg Little League, Inc. at Creekview Park shall be restricted as follows. Picnicking for the purposes of this resolution and enforcement of park rules and regulations is defined as consumption of food and/or beverage within the boundary of a park.


- (1) Picnicking shall be restricted to Pinebrook North where picnic tables and grills have been provided by the township. Picnicking shall not be permitted at Pinebrook South.

- (2) Picnicking shall be restricted to two pavilions at Brodhead Creek Park where eight tables and four grills have been provided by the township at each pavilion.
- (3) Picnicking shall not be permitted at Yetter Park.
- (4) Picnicking shall not be permitted in the area outside of premises leased to Stroudsburg Little League, Inc. at Creekview Park.
- (5) No portable tables, grills, tents or other portable products for the purpose of picnicking shall be permitted in Pinebrook, Brodhead Creek, and Yetter Parks and the area outside of premises leased to Stroudsburg Little League, Inc. at Creekview Park.


FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Stroud Township hereby declares that the Township property interests in and to the aforesaid parcels of land have been obtained or purchased and maintained, and have been established, for park and recreational purposes, for the free use and enjoyment by the citizens and taxpayers of Stroud Township, who bear the financial burden and expense for the said parks lands.
